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## "THE STATE AND LIFE CHANCES IN URBAN CHINA" PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The data collection for "the state and life chances" project was funded by a NSF grant (SBR9413540), and carried out by PI Xueguang Zhou and Co-PIs Phyllis Moen and Nancy Tuma, in collaboration with three Chinese institutions-the Department of Sociology at the People's University, the Institute of Sociology at Tianjin Academy of Social Sciences, and the Department of Sociology at Fudan University. The data collection was carried out by interviewers organized by the Chinese collaborating institutions from May to December of 1994.

## Data collection

The data collection process typically involved the following steps. The first step was sampling. Following multistage sampling procedures (see below), the research team in a collaborating institution conducted sampling work to identify the specific residential families for the interviewers to visit and collect data. In the second step, the research team organized training sessions for interviewers (most of them college students or researchers in the provincial academies of social sciences). The training was based on a training manual prepared by the PI, which provided detailed instructions on the specific questions to ask in filling out the questionnaire. The third step was to send interviewers to visit these families that were identified in the sampling procedures and randomly selected a qualified family member (aged between 25 and 65) to conduct the interview.

The data was collected based on a pre-tested questionnaire. The questionnaire asked retrospective information about respondents' experiences in educational attainment, movements across organizations, occupations, and geographic locations, as well as about their family structure, political status over time, and other variables (see Appendix A-the questionnaire for more information). In addition, if the respondent was married, we collected the same information for the spouse using an identical questionnaire. Spousal information could be provided by either the spouse or the respondent (if she or he was able to do so).

## Sampling

The sampling for this data set was based on a multistage sampling procedure. First, six provinces were selected for data collection, each representing a conventional geographic region in China. The selection of these provinces was made purposively by the PI, based on the knowledge of the political, economic and social environments across regions in China, and in consultation
with Chinese collaborators with regard to the research facilities and manpower in these provinces to carry out these interviews.

Second, in each province, we chose the capital city to represent large cities (population over 1 million). We randomly selected a medium-sized city (population between 200,000 and 1 million) and a small city (population under 200,000), based on the 1990 Yearbook of Chinese Cities (State Statistics Bureau 1990). The sample size for each city was proportional to the population in that size of city in that province. We also included Beijing, China's capital, and Shanghai, its largest industrial city in China, in our sample. In total, there are 20 cities in the sample, covering a variety of geographic locations and types of urban economies. Some minor adjustments were made in the distribution of samples across cities to increase the size of the samples in the cities in Gansu Province where the urban population was smaller than cities in other provinces.

Third, we selected a stratified random sample of each city's residents through the multistage sampling procedure. In China, a metropolitan city is composed of residential districts ( $\bar{\square}$ ). Each district is composed of residential "streets" ( $\bar{\square}$ ) which in turn is organized into residential blocks ( $\mathrm{Q}, \mathrm{Q}$ ). We selected residential blocks in each city using a systematic sampling scheme. That is, we selected every $n$th residential block based on the residential information in official statistics. We used an analogous sampling scheme to select households in each residential block. Finally, we randomly selected a member of the household between age 25 and 65 to be interviewed. Respondents included both current labor force participants and retirees.

## Additional Issues

Missing values. The general coding convention for missing information is as follows: "9 " for "not applicable"; "-8" for "refuse to answer"; and "-7" for "don't know." However, in the actual data collection process, the different categories of "missing information" were not always maintained consistently. It was conventional for the data entry operator to fill in "-9" when a cell was left blank (in most cases, these blank cells indicate "not applicable.").

Information on "party membership" (for respondent, spouse, and their respective parents) is missing in samples from two provinces (Guangdong, Jiangsu), because the variables with such information were deleted upon government request. We use " -1 " to indicate missing values for these variables with intentional, systematic missing information.

Although the data has been carefully scrutinized and cleaned, there are still cases where the information for a variable is problematic (for example, a salary value that is larger than
expected for the occupation in a certain year, a cadre occupation with a professional rank, etc.). We keep these problematic variables and cases in the data so that the user to exercise their judgments and devise ways to treat these issues. In our own empirical studies, we have dealt with these problematic cases and variables in accordance with our research purpose.

There were a few variables in our questionnaire that are known to be unreliable. These problems were mainly caused by the ambiguities in the questionnaire design. We deleted these variables from the data and from the questionnaire.

## Codebook for "The State and Life Chances in Urban China" Project

This codebook documents the raw data set, which is stored in the accompanying data file chance94.data. The data are not written in rectangular format nor are they stored in fixed column positions. Instead the data for each case are written in a multi-record format. Records are distinguished as to type and, within type, multiple records are written - one for each event reported by respondents. Within records, the only fixed field item is a 4-digit record type at the beginning of the record. The remainder of the information on each record is written in space delimited, free-field format.

The accompanying SAS program (chance94.sas) should be used to read the raw data. It produces in rectangular format a temporary SAS data set containing data for the studies 4073 cases. The program also contains SAS format modules for applying value labels to tabular outputs.

It is strongly recommended that users NOT make significant changes to the core DATA step comprising the chance 94 .sas program, as it is custom-tailored to the specific organization of these data and is of greater complexity than the typical SAS input DATA step. The only modifications that should be considered are:

- Making the output file a permanent SAS data set if desired
- Commenting out the FORMAT statement located in the terminal record (term:) processing stanza if you do not want formats associated with the variables

The end of the program has procedural code for producing content listings and formatted frequency or univariate output on all variables. This is commented out by default.

Event history data is by nature skewed with large numbers of people experiencing small numbers of an event type, but few experiencing many events. The raw data format stores and represents this information in a small compact format, but translating this into a rectangular format results in a much larger file consisting mostly of missing data. So storing the rectangular file permanently may not be desirable for many users. This code should allow you to generate it on a temporary basis whenever needed and then add subsequent DATA steps to transform and extract data as needed.

The organization of the first (master) record for each respondent is significant. In addition to identification variables, it contains a series of respondent and spouse count variables for each case. These variables indicate how many of each type of education, housing, work unit, job, income, father work or mother work records exist for the respondent and spouse. Use these variables as upper bounds on loops for processing specific types of information. If no such information exists of that type, the count is coded zero; so looping should be conditional on the count being a non-zero value.

The codebook contains the variable names used in the chance 94 .sas program. Certain naming conventions have generally been adhered to:

- Aside from identification variables, each variable starts with ' $R$ ' or ' S ' to indicate whether it is a 'Respondent-' or a 'Spouse-related' variable.
- For most variables the $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ letters of the variable name indicate which type of record they are derived form where:
- ED means 'education'
- HO means 'housing'
- WO means 'work unit'
- JO means 'job’
- IN means 'income'
- GF means 'grandfather-related'
- ES means 'eldest sibling-related'
- EC means 'eldest child-related'
- YC means 'youngest child-related'
- FA means 'father-related'
- MA means 'mother-related'
- There are a few variables relating to personal characteristics of the respondent or spouse where the above $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ letter convention does not apply [records $0700,0800,1700$ and 1800].
- The remainder of the variable name is used to convey content and sequence among a set of records where multiple episodes exist.
